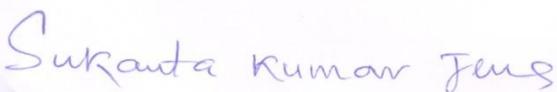
1. Nearly 50 Nos. Of students got placement in companies and some others joined Odisha Police, Defence and other Govt. Jobs.

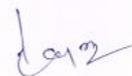
