DEPARTMENT AT A GLANCE

The Department of History in M.H.D Mahabidyalaya, Chhatia, Jajpur has its origin with the establishment of the college itself i.e. 1978-79 academic session at Intermediate level Prof. J.C. Mishra was the first H.O.D who also acted as the Principal of the college several times. Since then the department has been providing teaching facilities of satisfactory quality to the students. Teaching at undergraduate level began by the department in the year 1986 with a sanctioned strength of 96 seats followed by 128 seats and 256 seats subsequently. In view of the increasing demand and interest of the students, as well as resourceful faculties' qualitative education, the college authority felt the necessity of opening of Honours classes in the department. With an allocation of 16 seats from the session 1992_93 Honours teaching is provided to the students. History as an elective subject at under graduate level has been introduced from the academic session 2002-2003 with the modification of degree syllabus by Utkal University as per the U.G.C guidelines. At present the department is imparting teaching in Honours, Pass, Elective and Indian society and culture. C.B.C.S pattern has been introduced in +3 1st year from the current session i.e. 2016-17.

Starting with Prof. J. C. Mishra & Prof. S. Das the department is flourished with the HoDs and all faculty members by their efforts in different periods. At present Prof. N.C.Tripathy of the department is acting as HoD along with other faculty members Prof. C.R Sahoo , Prof. B.B.Sahoo & Mrs K.Sahoo. The members of the department are making best efforts to instill new ideas of creativity into the minds of the students, which will definitely enable them to face the challenges at every moment of life.

The dynamic character of history demands fresh insight and approach from the learned scholars and teachers. The members of the department are conscious of such demands of insight and knowledge of history. In order to achieve the above demands they are attending different Refresher Courses

organized by different academic staff colleges and UGC sponsored National and State Level Seminars. The department is trying all its efforts to enrich the knowledge of the students by organizing seminars, conducting tests, organizing study-tour to nearby historical places, providing teaching materials etc.

Last but not the least the department wishes all the best to its students to reach the pinnacle of success.

ACTIVITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT

1. Unit wise tests are held to assess the progress of the students and prepare them for the university Examination. The valued answer scripts are shown to the students to let them know their mistakes and deficiencies and necessary suggestions and ideas are given to them by the teachers for their improvement.
2. Remedial and extra-classes are arranged by the teachers to encourage academically weak students.
3. Study-tours and picnic to important historical sites are organized for the students every year to arouse their interest to know about the rich cultural heritage of the country and to develop a spirit of historical & cultural consciousness.
4. Group discussions are conducted among the honours students to enhance their competitive ability and self-confidence.
5. Students are further encouraged to participate and involve themselves in the social service wings of the college like NSS and YRC
6. The department is organizing routine activities such as Welcome Ceremony for New Honours Students, Farewell Ceremony for Outgoing Students, Teacher's Day celebration, Ganesh Puja and Saraswati Puja as a mark of honour for social tradition.
